

O R D I N A N C E NO. 7-89-1

AN ORDINANCE TO DECLARE UNLAWFUL THE DRINKING OR OPEN OR UNCONCEALED POSSESSION OR CUSTODY FOR DRINKING IN PUBLIC OF LIQUOR, WINE MALT BEVERAGES OR BREWED BEVERAGES AND THE DRINKING OR OPEN OR UNCONCEALED POSSESSION OR CUSTODY FOR DRINKING OF LIQUOR, WINE MALT BEVERAGES OR BREWED BEVERAGES IN ANY LICENSED LIQUOR OR LICENSED BEER PLACE IN THE CITY OF ABBEVILLE AT ANY TIME AFTER 2:00 A.M. ON SUNDAY, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED; AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR ITS VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Abbeville, Alabama, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 4, Article 1 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Abbeville, be amended by adding Section 4-5 which shall read as follows:

"Sec. 4-5. Drinking or possession of alcoholic beverages in public and on Sunday.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to drink, or have in open or unconcealed possession or custody for drinking, any liquor or wine, at or in any public place in the city other than inside the building of a licensed liquor place.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to drink, or have in open or unconcealed possession or custody for drinking, any malt beverage or brewed beverage, at or in any public place in the city other than inside the building of a licensed beer place or licensed liquor place.

(c) It shall be unlawful for any person to drink, or have in open or unconcealed possession or custody for drinking, any liquor, wine, malt beverage or brewed beverage, at or in any licensed beer place or licensed liquor place in the city at any time after 2:00 a. m. on Sunday, except in bona fide private clubs where permitted by state alcoholic beverage control board regulations."

Section 2. The provisions of this ordinance are severable.

If any part of this ordinance is declared invalid or

unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the part which remains.


Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective on August 7, 1989, or upon its approval by the City Council, whichever occurs last, or upon its otherwise becoming law, but shall nevertheless be published as required by law and codified as part of the Code of Ordinances, City of Abbeville,
