

ORDINANCE NO. 12-99-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABBEVILLE, ALABAMA TO CLOSE THOSE PORTIONS OF TRAWICK STREET AND COLLEGE STREET THAT GO THROUGH THE CAMPUS OF ABBEVILLE HIGH SCHOOL TO THROUGH TRAFFIC FROM 7:30 A.M. TO 2:40 P.M. EACH DAY DURING THE TIME SCHOOL IS IN SESSION AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Abbeville, Alabama, A Municipal Corporation, as follows:

SECTION I. ACTIVITY PROHIBITED

That it shall be unlawful for the operator of any motorized vehicle to pass through or go around the traffic control devices which have been placed on Trawick Street and College Street to limit access to the campus of Abbeville High School. Those portions of Trawick Street and College Street which go through the campus of Abbeville High School shall be closed to through traffic from 7:30 A.M. to 2:40 P.M. each day during the time school is in session.

SECTION II. ACTIVITY EXCLUDED FROM ORDINANCE

This ordinance will not apply to the operators of motorized vehicles who have official business at Abbeville High School.

SECTION III. PENALTY

That any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00), plus court costs.

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the part which remains.

SECTION V. REPEAL.

This ordinance does not repeal any other prior ordinance concerning the regulation of public streets which has been previously adopted by the City of Abbeville, Alabama, a municipal corporation.

SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE.


The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
