

**ORDINANCE NO. 6-04-1**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABBEVILLE, ALABAMA TO DESIGNATE THE INTERSECTION OF CLARK STREET AND CRAWFORD STREET AS A THREE WAY STOP INTERSECTION.**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Abbeville, Alabama, A Municipal Corporation, as follows:

**SECTION I. DESIGNATION OF THREE WAY STOP INTERSECTION**

The intersection of **Crawford Street** and **Clark Street** shall be designated as a **three way stop** intersection. Every driver of a vehicle traveling **eastbound** approaching the stop sign erected on **Crawford Street** shall stop at the clearly marked stop sign. After having stopped, the driver shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle already stopped at either of the two (2) other three way stop signs. The driver of the first vehicle which approached and stopped at the intersection shall thence proceed. The driver of the second vehicle which approached and stopped at the intersection shall thence proceed. The driver of the third vehicle which approached and stopped at the intersection shall thence proceed. Every driver of a vehicle traveling **westbound** approaching the stop sign erected on **Crawford Street** shall stop at the clearly marked stop sign. After having stopped, the driver shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle already stopped at either of the two (2) other three way stop signs. The driver of the first vehicle which approached and stopped at the intersection shall thence proceed. The driver of the second vehicle which approached and stopped at the intersection shall thence proceed. The driver of the third vehicle which approached and stopped at the intersection shall thence proceed. Every driver of a vehicle traveling **northbound** approaching the stop sign erected on **Clark Street** shall stop at the clearly marked stop sign. After having stopped, the driver shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle already stopped at either of the two (2) other three way stop signs. The driver of the first vehicle which approached and stopped at the intersection shall thence proceed. The driver of the second vehicle which approached and stopped at the intersection shall thence proceed. The driver of the third vehicle which approached and stopped at the intersection shall thence proceed.

**SECTION II. PENALTY**

That any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00), plus court costs.

**SECTION III. SEVERABILITY**

The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the part which remains.

**SECTION IV. REPEAL**

This ordinance does not repeal any other prior ordinance concerning the regulation of public streets which has been previously adopted by the City of Abbeville, Alabama, a municipal corporation.

**SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE**

The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
