Festival Rules

1. The Abbeville Chamber of Commerce, Yatta Abba Day Festival, or City of Abbeville will assume no responsibility for damages, loss, or theft of merchandise.
2. Deadline for registration must be postmarked by Friday, April 13, 2012. Exhibit fees are not refunded to Exhibitor because of cancellation on Exhibitor's part.
3. Food Vendors are responsible for their own health permits. Health permits can be obtained from the Henry County Health Department at 334.585.2660. Food Vendors are required to call the Health Department for information on permitted foods and preparation methods.
4. Spaces will be pre-assigned on a first-come basis. This is determined by receipt and approval of application, NOT on arrival at the festival. Preferences will be considered but are not guaranteed.
5. Set up will begin at 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 21. All booths must be set up by 8:30 a.m.
6. No auto traffic will be allowed in the festival area after 8:30 a.m.
7. Booths cannot be broken down before 4:00 p.m. Vehicles will not be permitted in the Festival area before 4:00 pm.
8. You must supply your own racks, tables, chairs, covers, etc. The coordinator holds the right to have any item or exhibit removed which is determined to be in bad taste.
9. No open containers, mixed drinks, beer, etc. will be tolerated. No drugs allowed. No weapons allowed.
10. Security: Security will be on hand the day of the Festival; however, each vendor exhibits all work at his/her own risk. The Festival is not responsible for damage, theft, or loss of an individual's work.
