1. CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Jim Giganti called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with Terry Allums, Billy Helms, Brendt Murphy, Eddie Jones, and Betty Yoder in attendance. Also in attendance was City Clerk/Treasurer Pam Ward.
2. PRAYER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE - Eddie Jones
3. VISITORS:
 - a. Lucky Armstrong – Announced the Cemetery committee had received a grant award of \$2,500 from the Alabama Historic Commission.
 - b. Tom Wojtala – spoke in support of Police Chief Marlos Walker and appreciated his professionalism.
 - c. Patrolman Colt Ludlum – tendered his resignation effective 2/8/15 to the Council
4. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES
 - a. 1/19/2015 – Regular Meeting – Upon motion by Allums and second by Murphy, the Council unanimously approved the minutes.
5. REQUEST FROM SPECTRACARE FOR USE OF THE HERNDON-WARD GYM ON 3/11/15; 4/15/15; 5/13/15; AND 6/10/15 FOR APPROXIMATELY ONE HOUR EACH DAY. Upon motion by Murphy and second by Allums, the Council unanimously approved the use of the gym.

Upon motion by Yoder and second by Murphy, the Council unanimously approved the reappointments of Max Mobley and Elijah Baker.
9. DISCUSSION ON POLICE CHIEF PAY STATUS AND JOB REQUIREMENTS – Mayor Giganti advised the Council that he had received a legal opinion that if the Chief was required to live in Abbeville, all employees would have to be treated the same. Discussion was tabled until next meeting.
