1. CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Jim Giganti called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with Brendt Murphy, Eddie Jones and Betty Yoder in attendance. Terry Allums and Billy Helms were absent. Also present, was Clerk/Treasurer Pam Ward.
2. PRAYER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE – Brendt Murphy
3. VISITORS:
 - a. There were none.
4. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES
 - a. 6/1/2015 – Regular Meeting – Upon motion by Murphy and second by Yoder, the minutes were unanimously approved.
5. REQUEST FOR UNITY DAY ON JULY 4TH – GIRARD PARK – Upon motion by Murphy and second by Jones, the Girard Park was approved for use from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on July 4th with the authority given to Chief Wright to shut down the park should any serious incidents arise. Motion carried unanimously.

Gilliam Street will remain open.
7. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF NEW EMPLOYEE INSURANCE PROGRAM – Upon motion by Murphy and second by Yoder, the Council unanimously approved the new life insurance program presented by Campus Benefits.
8. DISCUSSION CONCERNING MAKING DOSWELL STREET AND WILLIAMS STREET A FOUR WAY STOP – Upon motion by Yoder and second by Murphy, the Council voted to make the intersection of Doswell St. and E. Williams St. and four way stop. Motion passed unanimously.
9. ASSIGNMENT OF SURPLUS INVENTORY AND REQUEST TO DONATE SAME – Upon motion by Murphy and second by Jones, the Council unanimously approved the donation of six walkie talkies to Blountsville Police Department.
