COUNCIL MEETING

1. CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Jim Giganti called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with Terry Allums, Brendt Murphy, Eddie Jones, and Billy Helms in attendance. Also in attendance was Clerk/Treasurer Pam Ward. Betty Yoder was absent.
2. PRAYER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE – Terry Allums
3. VISITORS:
  - a. Robert Wright – Public Works Superintendant gave an update on the limbs and debris pickup and advised the boom truck was down for repairs. He also advised the fuel injector may be bad in the leaf truck. He advised Council that due to equipment issues, we were no longer on a specified daily route for pickup. We are currently running the route on a continuous loop with no specific pickup date.
4. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES
  - a. 4/7/2014 – Regular Meeting – Upon motion by Allums and second by Jones, the minute were unanimously approved.
5. REQUEST APPROVAL OF TWO JOB DESCRIPTIONS AND AMEND DEPARTMENT ORGANIZATIONAL CHART
  - A. COMMUNICATIONS SUPERVISOR
  - B. TRAINING COORDINATORUpon motion by Allums and second by Murphy, the Council approved the two new job classifications and rate plan for same.
6. REQUEST APPROVAL FOR SALE OF SURPLUS INDUSTRIAL PARK TIMBER LAND – Request died for lack of a motion.
7. DISCUSSION AND REQUEST VOTE TO PURCHASE SECURITY CAMERAS FOR GIRARD PARK – Upon motion by Jones and second by Murphy, the Council unanimously approved the purchase of the cameras from Tyco System for \$2,999.  
  
Upon motion by Allums and second by Helms, the Council approved the repair/replacement of the fence and gate along Gilliam Street at the basketball courts and any needed signage.

9. COMMENTS FROM COUNCIL
