1. CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Pro Tem Terry Allums called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. with Brendt Murphy, Eddie Jones, Billy Helms and Betty Yoder in attendance. Mayor Giganti was absent. Also present was Clerk/Treasurer Pam Ward.
2. PRAYER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE – Betty Yoder
3. VISITORS:
 - a. Mrs. Gwen Baker complimented the Abbeville Police Department on the outstanding job they did during the Unity Day events. Mrs. Baker also requested the city purchase an extra large stretcher for the ambulances. Mrs. Baker was advised she would have to speak with the Abbeville EMS as they were a private corporation and separate from the city.
